

I am proud of your accomplishments. Sister Stoker joins me in sending our love and gratitude for your faithful missionary service.

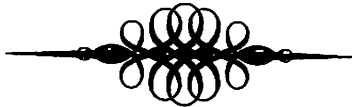



QUALIFICATION

The first step to becoming an effective teacher is to "Qualify." All missionaries must complete the requirements for Qualification by their third month in the mission field.

When first signing off a discussion to the Trainer, new missionaries are to recite, verbatim, the entire discussion (including scriptures) at one sitting. (Missionaries who are no longer in their training companionship must pass off the entire discussion and scriptures to their District Leader). Later, the Zone Leader/District Leader "spot-checks" the discussion by asking the missionary to recite one principle from each discussion (once again, scriptures included). The missionary must prove to have mastered both the discussion and scriptures before the Zone Leader/District Leader gives his final approval.

There are certain privileges involved in completing the first level of mastery, "Qualification." After you pass-off all of the missionary discussions, you are then allowed to listen to approved mission music (see "Mission Music"). In addition, you will have the allowance, if the opportunity arises, to drive an automobile.

Sister Stoker and I are very proud of you, of what you have done, and of what you are continuing to accomplish.

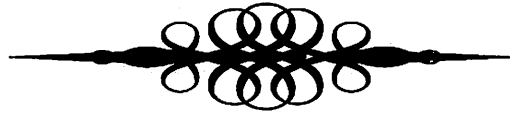



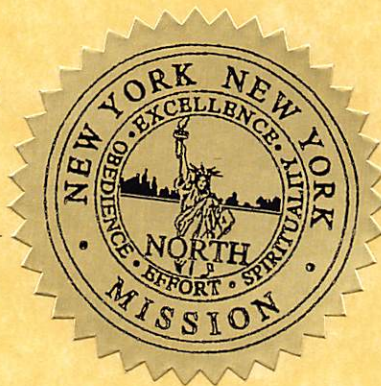

MASTERY

Mastery is the final level of achievement in the Mastery Program, but is by no means the end of doctrinal study. A missionary who has "Mastered," demonstrates that he/she desires to serve as an effective instrument in the Lord's hands thereby understanding that to maintain such a level of efficiency, he/she must continually review the previously learned material, as well as strive to learn and apply new skills and information.

Missionaries working on achieving the Mastery level should complete all of the following requirements by their twelfth month (year mark) in the mission field.
